

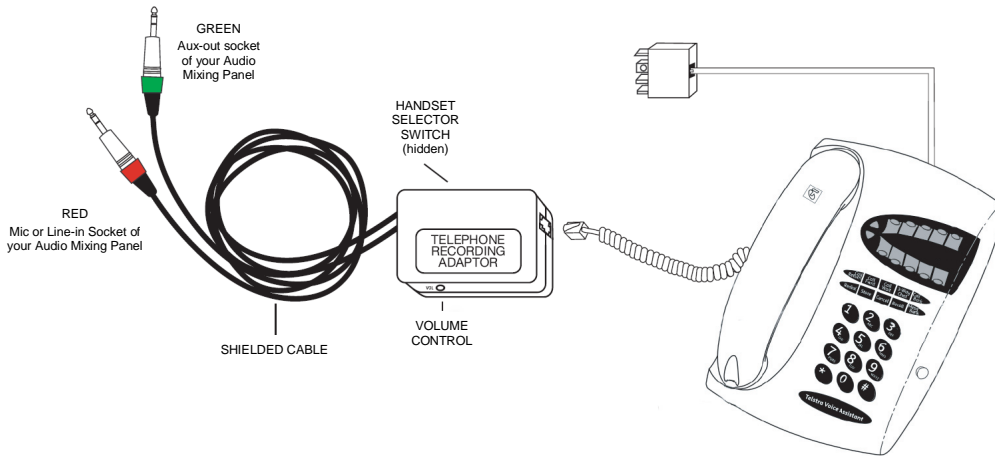
Trillium Telephone Recording Adapter Studio Interface REC-ADPT-SI User Guide

1 Introduction

The Trillium Studio Interface Telephone Recording Adapter connects your telephone to an audio mixing panel allowing you to use your studio equipment to hold and record telephone conversations. It can be used with most telephones fitted with a modular handset cord. A volume control is provided to adjust the audio level from you mixing panel to match the levels required by your telephone.

2 Installing your Studio Interface Adaptor

The drawing below shows a typical installation.



1. Unplug the telephone handset cord from the handset.
2. Plug the handset cord from your telephone into the Studio Interface adaptor. The Studio Interface replaces the telephone handset – both cannot be used!
NOTE: On some telephone keysystems a “headset mode” can be selected this allows the keyset to be used without lifting the handset.
3. Plug the red connector (6.3 mm stereo plug) into a “Line-in” or “Microphone” socket of your audio mixing panel.
4. Plug the green connector into an appropriate “Aux Out” socket of your audio mixing panel.
5. Select the correct Handset Selector switch position to suit your telephone.
6. Make a call and adjust the input and output levels appropriately.

NOTE: The REC-ADPT-SI has a transmit level attenuator. If the levels from the audio panel are too high, this will result in a distorted send audio (the audio received at the far end). Turning the volume control anticlockwise will reduce the send signal level.
