The Trillium Recording Adaptor is ideal for recording telephone conversations, for later reference, to confirm details of the conversation, such as; the order quantity, agreed price, name,

telephone number, address or credit card details. It is also extremely useful for recording telephone interviews and conference calls for later transcription or minute taking.

Telephone Plug.

4-Way Modular Plug connects into your telephone handset socket. (Length 300mm)



Handset Socket.

4-Way Modular socket allows connection of your telephone handset or headset.



Stereo Output Plug.

Shielded Lead with 3.5mm Stereo Phono Plug for connection to a recording device. (Length 2.0m)



Handset Selector Switch.

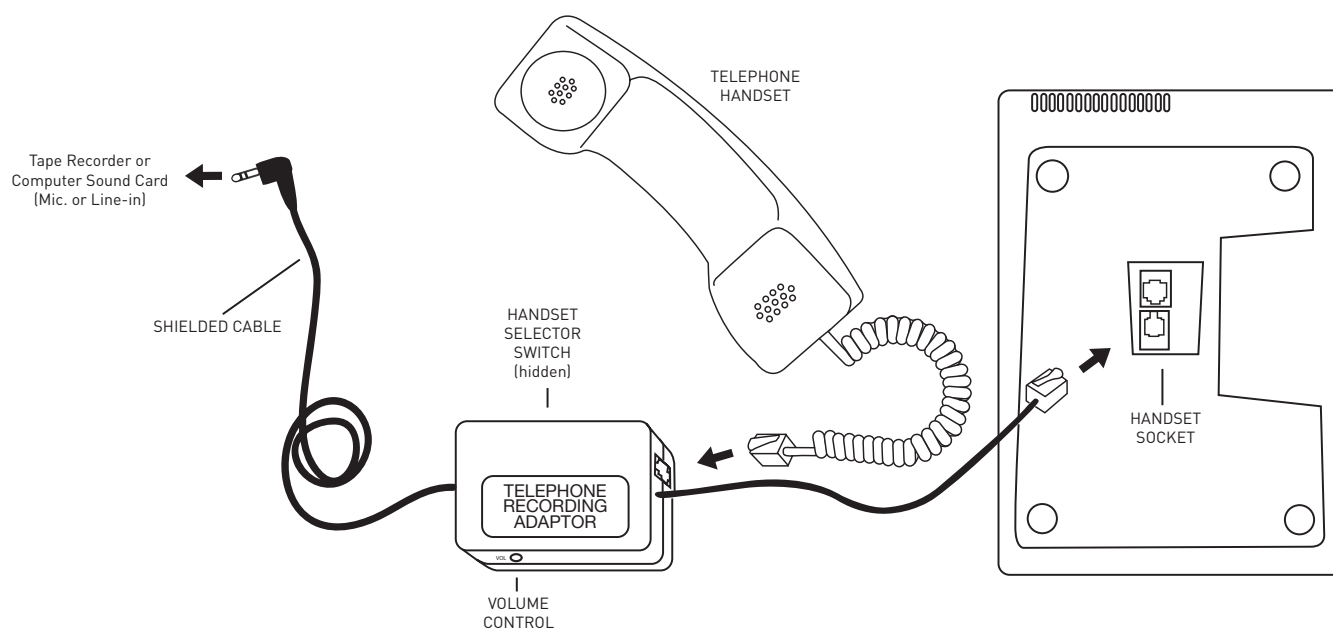
Selects the correct handset wiring type to suit your telephone.



Volume Control.
