




**Recording Adapter: REC-ADPT
User Guide**

1. Introduction:

The Trillium Recording Adapter provides a connection from your telephone to your Computer or Tape Recorder for recording your telephone conversations. It can be used with most telephones fitted with a modular handset cord. A level control is provided to allow reduction of the record level.

2. Installing your Telephone Recording Adaptor:

The drawing below shows a typical installation.



1. Unplug the telephone line.
2. Unplug the telephone handset cord from the telephone.
3. Plug the Recording Adaptor telephone handset cord into the telephone handset socket.
4. Plug the Telephone handset cord into the handset socket on the Recording Adaptor
5. Plug the telephone in the telephone line and check that the handset is working normally.
6. Plug the 3.5mm recording plug into the “line-in” or “Microphone” socket of your computer sound card or tape recorder.

3. Selecting the Handset Wiring

1. Dial a friend or information service where continuous receive voice can be heard.
2. Record a short period of voice with the handset selector switch in position 1 then position 2. Play back the recording - noting in which position the voice is recorded and then select this position for the handset selector switch.

4. Setting the Volume Control level

Record further voice and adjust the volume control on the Recording Adapter to ensure non-distorted voice is being recorded.
